APPLICATION PROCEDURES

The MATCEI Scholarship Program is designed to provide support to university students in teacher training programs. Current members of the organization may apply for a \$500 grant to assist with tuition and fees. Applications for the scholarships will be acted upon by the Board of Directors and their decision will be final. The following requirements will be adhered to:

1. Applicants must be current members of MATCEI.
2. Applicants should be at least junior status and show evidence of acceptance into an EI teacher certification program. Full time students in undergraduate and graduate programs may apply.
3. Four \$500 scholarships will be awarded.
4. Applicants must provide the following:
 - a. A completed application
 - b. Three professional and personal references (forms are included)
 - c. College transcript
 - d. Professional resume
 - e. Proof of acceptance into EI teacher certification program.
